Swim with sea-lions and dolphins

Baird Bay \$140 per person

This is an amazing experience - you may have swum with dolphins at other places around the world but the interaction that you will have with the sea-lions and dolphins at Baird Bay will leave you breathless. The tour is 3-4 hours, wetsuit and snorkel equipment is provided at no additional cost.

Hand feed and swim with tuna

Port Lincoln \$80 per person

This is like swimming with lightning - hand feed and swim with Bluefin Tuna while they are feeding. These fish can travel at speeds up to 80kms per hour so this really is an amazing experience and completes the wildlife encounter package.

Cage dive with great white sharks - Port Lincoln

Calypso Star \$495 per person (*Non Dive option available)

The first one day shark tour in Australia on the purpose built, MV Calypso Star 2- all meals and drinks are included. Sharks are easily visible from the boat. Each person will spend a minimum of 30 minutes in the actual cage. When booked through Nullarbor Traveller - a wetsuit and video highlights package is also included in the price (normal value \$75.00).

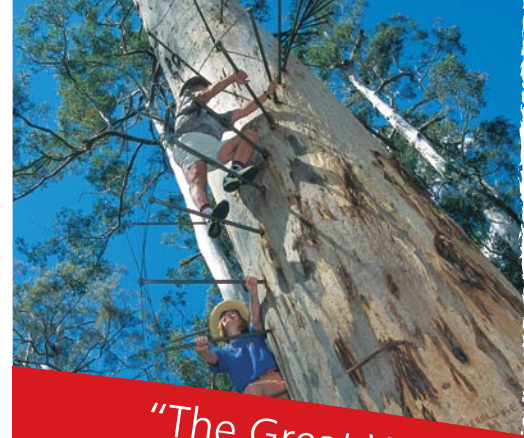
Adventure Bay Charters *\$395 per person

This tour does not use berley to attract sharks. Opportunities to see sharks from the surface, included is a light breakfast, morning tea, lunch, all day tea, coffee. Wetsuits are included and on board training in "Surface supply diving" is provided. Photos are loaded/available of your tour on the website free of charge.

Adelaide: Adelaide Bus Station, 101 Franklin Street. Pick up from 5am. *It is important that reconfirmation is made 48hours prior to departure. The departures ex Adelaide have specific transport connections and the tour is unable to delay departure.*

Perth: Tourist Coach Rank, Wellington Street 7am - YHA central 7.05am *Please reconfirm 48hours prior to the date of departure. Early confirmations may allow us to pick you up direct from your inner city hotel or hostel.*

What Accommodation, Vehicles and Facilities are used?

Our vehicles are 21 seater deluxe air conditioned Toyota coaster buses with a maximum of 18 people (between Coodlie Park and Esperance).

Accommodation on the tour is a mixture of national parks, camp grounds, bush camps [no facilities] and farm retreat.

When camping, we use individual swags. (Our wet weather option is 3 person dome tents with a maximum of 2 people per tent)

A maximum of 15kg in one backpack/travel case and one piece of hand luggage. Walking shoes, water bottle, insect repellent, sunscreen, hat, bathing suits, torch, head lamp and rainproof jacket.
